## Trip Details

### **Day 1 (18 Mar 2026): Arrival Phnom Penh**

Welcome to Phnom Penh, a capital city of Cambodia.

Upon arrival **Techo International Airport** (KTI), meet and greet with **English-speaking tour guide**.

Transfer to the hotel for check in and refresh.

Hotel check in time at 14:00, early check in depend on room availability.

Late afternoon tour guide picks up for **Cyclo Ride Tour** aka bicycle rickshaw to see the highlight part of the city. Drive through bustling streets, local markets, Khmer street stalls to get more unique perspective of Phnom Penh.

Stay overnight in hotel.

### **Day 2 (19 Mar 2026): Phnom Penh City Tour [B]**

Have breakfast in hotel.

Today start the tour to visit **Royal Palace** is a complex of buildings which serves as the royal residence of the **King** of Cambodia with 174,870 square meters. Royal Palace is divided by walls into four main compounds. As the official residence of the **King**, so not all of the Palaces are open to visitors.

Visit **Silver Pagoda** is a compound located on the South side of the palace complex; the Silver Pagoda is named because of its floor which is made up of 5000 silver tiles. Its main building houses many national treasures such as gold and jeweled Buddha statues.

Continue to visit **Independence Monument** was built in 1958 to memorialize Cambodia's Independence from France and then visit our Late King Statue **Norodom Sihanouk** who was the King declared Independence from France.

Next visit **Russian Market** is one of the most popular tourist markets among tourists and expats and probably the best place for souvenirs. It does not look like much from the outside but when you get in you will find everything from beautifully hand carved statues, colorful lanterns, fabrics, silk scarves, printed T-shirts, DVDs, food, and more.

Afternoon visit **Wat Phnom** is the tallest religious structure in the city and the symbol & charming central point of Phnom Penh city.



Next continue to visit **Ounalom Pagoda** is a large complex with quarters for monks, nuns, classrooms, meditation centers, as well as halls, shrines and stupas. It is considered the most important pagoda in Phnom Penh city and the center of Cambodian Buddhism.

(Note: Getting water blessing from Buddhist monk is available. If you want to do, please check with tour guide).

Evening enjoy **1h sunset boat tour** at 4 junctions river. You will see Phnom Penh skyline from a different perspective and enjoy the spectacular view of Phnom Penh city at night.

Tour ends and back to the hotel for refresh then free your own program.

Stay overnight in hotel.

### Day 3 (20 Mar 2026): Phnom Penh City Tour [B]

Have breakfast in hotel.

Today will visit **Cheung Ek Killing Field** is the site of a former orchard and mass grave of victims of the [Khmer Rouge](#) - killed. It is the best-known of the sites known as Killing Field where the [Khmer Rouge](#) regime executed over one million people between 1975 and 1979.

To continue the story will visit **Toul Sleng Genocide Museum** (S21) is a former high school which was used as the notorious Security Prison 21 (S-21) by the Khmer Rouge regime from its rise to power in 1975 to its fall in 1979. Toul Sleng means "Hill of the Poisonous Trees".

Afternoon visit **National Museum** is Cambodia largest museum of cultural history and is the country leading historical and archaeological museum. The museum house is one of the world largest collections of Khmer art. Its collection includes over 14,000 items from prehistoric times to periods before during and after the Khmer Empire.

Tour ends and back to then hotel for refresh then free your own program.

Stay overnight in hotel.

### Day 4 (21 Mar 2026): Departure Phnom Penh -> Siem Reap [B]

Have breakfast in hotel.

Hotel check out time at 12:00 PM.

Transfer to visit **Siem Reap** with tour guide approx. 6h drive.

En-route you will see the beautiful scenery of Cambodia countryside.

You will also see vendors sell eatable fried spider, seasonal fruit, and snacks at the halfway stop known as **SKON area**. Next stop will visit **Ancient Naga Bridge** in Kompong Kdei is a historically significant bridge which was built in 12th century.

Arrival **Siem Reap** then directly go to hotel for check in and refresh.

Evening tour guide pick up for **Street food tour** at Street 60 where you can see local people gathering and enjoy their evening after working hour. Enjoy testing local food.

Stay overnight in hotel.

### Day 5 (22 Mar 2026): World Heritage Temple Tour [B]

Have breakfast in hotel.



Today will visit the world heritage temple, visit **Angkor Wat Temple** is the world largest temple with excellent masterpiece of carvings, sculptures, and perfect structure. Angkor Wat is the symbol of Cambodia tourism.

Continue to visit the impressive **Angkor Thom City Complex** which includes:

Start at **South Gate of Angkor Thom** or **Tonle Om River** is one of the five ancient gates dated to the 12th century providing access through the 8m high laterite walls of [Angkor Thom](#). Tonle Om South Gate is a famous spot and spectacle not to be missed.

Next visit **Bayon Temple** (Giant Buddha Face temple) is another main temple of Cambodia. Bayon Temple's most distinctive feature is the multitude of serene and smiling stone faces of The Buddha - probably modeled on the face of King Jayavarman VII - on every side the many towers that jut out from the upper terrace and cluster around its central peak. Bayon has become one of the most recognizable images connected to classic Khmer art and architecture. Another one is **Ta Prom Temple** is a fabulous temple covered by dense tropical forest. Its state of ruin is a state of beauty which is investigated with delight and left with regret. Ta Prohm is also a place where famous Hollywood movie Tomb Raider Movie starred by Angelina Jolie was filmed.

Last one visit **Pre-Rub Temple** is a Hindu temple mountain at Angkor. This temple mountain is one of best places for catching beautiful sunset.

Tour ends and back to the hotel for refresh then free your own program.

Stay overnight in hotel.

#### Day 6 (23 Mar 2026): Fly to Hanoi - Street food tour [B/D]

This morning, you will take a flight to Hanoi. After reaching hotel, our guide will bring you around Hanoi Old Town by walking for 3-4 hours to discover Hanoi Old Quarter, Hoan Kiem lake, Hanoi church, Hanoi railway... During trip, you will try some authentic local food such as: Noodle (Pho), Bread (Banh My), Egg coffee, mixed fruits...

### **Day 14 (31 Mar 2026): Ho Chi Minh city – Cu Chi tunnel full day [B/L]**



**07:45** Pick up you at meeting point or hotels, start to downtown of Ho Chi Minh for touring along the famous Dong Khoi street, passing by the Opera House, Town Hall, Notre Dame Cathedral & central Post Office and Independent Palace. Lunch at a local restaurant. In the afternoon, we are heading to Hoc Mon District to visit the Cu Chi Tunnels, is 70 kilometers Northwest of down-town Ho Chi Minh City. The Cu Chi Tunnel system had been created long time back, from 1948 to assist Viet Minh in the combat with French. Back to the hotel in the late afternoon.

### **Day 15 (01 Apr 2026): Ho Chi Minh - Mekong delta one day trip [B/L]**

07:30 Our tour guide will pick you up your hotel. Depart to Phong Nam.

10:15 Arrive at Phong Nam pier. Take the boat along the Chết Sậy river – one of branch of Mekong river, sight – seeing daily activities along the river like fishing, water transferring...Stop at the brickwork to see the local people make brick by hand (traditional way). Enjoy fresh coconut juice.

11:45 Visit coconut husking factory, to see the local people husking coconut by hand. Then, continue with boat. Visit one of the plenty of coconut processing workshop where coconut candy are made and have a chance to learn the coconut candy making process located along the canal (Lan Thanh coconut candy workshop) – taste tropical fruit – honey tea

12:30 Turn on natural scissors creeks where they look smaller and smaller to go to the village. Take a walk to the family making sleeping mat. Afterward, being on motor cart or biking and traveling through some traquil villages where vegetable garden to be able to touch on real life and find out tropical culture from peasants.

13:15 Lunch at the local restaurant.

14:30 Take the rowing boat at the small canal.

Arrive Nhà Việc bridge – get on bus and back to Ho Chi Minh City.

19:00 Finish tour at your hotel.

19:00hrs Depart from the hotel by local transportation “Tuk Tuk” to Warorot Market which is known locally as “Kad Luang” This is the Main local market. The market has been with Chiang Mai city for more than 100 years. Inside the market, we will be tasting fresh seasonal tropical fruits, freshly made Northern Thai sausage-Sai Oua and wash it all down with the famous Thai Iced Tea which is made according to local taste.

20:00hrs After your experience with Chiang Mai local shopping, Take a ride to the night market on Chang Puak Gate or North Gate is always busy and offers a great range of authentic Thai cuisine. Try the stewed pork leg from the famous vendor with the cowboy hat who's had visits from the likes of Anthony Bourdain. Taste Bua Loi, or floating lotus, is a warm fresh coconut milk broth with teeny pandan-laced glutinous rice flour balls swimming around.

21:00hrs Take a ride with Tuk Tuk to see Chiang Mai nightlife around the old city before transferring back to the hotel. O/n at the same hotel in

### **Day 20 (06 Apr 2026): Chiang Mai City tour [B]**



Have breakfast at your hotel. Begin your tour by heading to the centre of Chiang Mai where you will visit the Tapae Gate. This was once one of five gates into the walled city, and is now the main one, having been the only gate to be fully reconstructed. This is a great spot to start your introduction to the history of Chiang Mai.

From here you will venture onwards by pedal-powered trishaw, stopping briefly at the Three Kings Monument before continuing to Wat Phra Singh. This is one of the city's most revered temples and offers an excellent example of classic Lanna architecture. It is most well-known for its beautiful Phra Singh (Lion Buddha) image, which is housed in a small but ornate chapel, and first came to Chiang Mai in the 1360s.

You will then take a stroll to Wat Chedi Luang. This was originally one of the tallest buildings in ancient Chiang Mai, however, it was significantly damaged either in an earthquake or from cannon fire. Whilst it no longer boasts a towering spire, there has been extensive restoration work to the exterior, including new Buddha images, nagas and elephant statues. The temple was also the previous home of the Emerald Buddha, currently in Bangkok, and visitors can now see a jade replica, which was given as a royal gift in 1995 to celebrate the 700th anniversary of Chiang Mai.

A pleasant winding drive up to Wat Prathat Doi Suthep, the symbol of Chiang Mai, where the holy relic of the Lord Buddha is enshrined. 2 magnificent Nagas act as guardians as you ascend up the steps to the temple. A splendid view of town and the surrounding country-side can be seen from the temple grounds.

Experience life with the elephants in their natural home as well as gain an insight into their history. Spend time with these amazing animals with friendly and happy elephants in a safe area. Feed, Cook Herbal, Roaming and Bathing elephant in the River.

8.30 am. Pick up from your hotel or accommodation in Chiangmai City.

09.00 am Drive approximately 50 Mins North of Chiang Mai through rolling hills, forest, and local farming areas.

10.00 am Arrive at Kanta Elephant Sanctuary, change into traditional clothing

10.30 am Prepare fruits for our elephants and Meet our elephants. Feed, Roaming, Observing, Playing with elephants. \*\*\* At the Sanctuary, we will allow you to spend as much time as possible with the elephants.

12.00 am Lunch

13.00 pm Prepare and cook sticky rice mixed with herbs for our elephants. Learn about Background, health care and behavior of Elephant.

14.00 pm Enjoy more time roaming, feeding and taking elephant walk to the river and enjoy Bathe, scrub elephants. Feed sticky rice balls, Fruits to Our elephants. \*\* This part is focused



on taking your time to observe and allowing the elephants to enjoy each moment of their freedom, scratching, rubbing, throwing dirt, enjoy the view and take lots of pictures\*\*  
15.00 pm. Tea and coffee break.

Leave Kanta Elephant Sanctuary and drive approximately 50 Mins back to Chiang Mai. Drop off at your hotel or accommodation.

Overnight in Chiang Mai

### **Day 22 (08 Apr 2026): Chiang Mai - Chiang Rai [B]**

Drive to visit the hot spring on the way to Chiang Rai .Continue driving for 1.5 hours to White temple (Wat Rong Khun).Then carry on to the three country borders, which are called ' Golden Triangle. After lunch (pay on own), drive to Maesai , the Thailand & Myanmar border city . Finally, visit the Long Neck hill tribe villages . Then transfer to Hotel in Chiang Rai

Overnight in Chiang Rai

### **Day 23 (09 Apr 2026): Full day tour in Doi Mae Salong - Doi Tung [B]**

After breakfast, visit Doi Mae Salong where you will visit the Chinese village on the mountaintop and buy some of the local products for example; tea, coffee and fruit for the gifts. Along the way stop at the Hot Spa and see nature which offers beautiful scenery. Usually in the cool season the Thai Cherry trees are in full bloom and you can touch the mountain mists here. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant ( Pay on own). Continue the trip to the highest peak on the Thai-Myanmar border. Doi Tung provides an opportunity to view many different Lahu and Akha villages as well as terraced farming areas and see from a distance the Princess Mother's frigid flower Garden. Doi Tung temple, built in A.D.1493, is located at the peak. Its scenery reminds one of Switzerland, features many unique images and temple architecture overlooking the entire northern rice field plain. Return to the hotel.

Overnight in Chiang Rai

### **Day 24 (10 Apr 2026): Chiang Rai - Bangkok [B]**

Check out , meet the driver and transfer to Chiang Rai Airport for your flight to Bangkok . Upon arrival in Bangkok, meet the tour guide and transfer to boarding a private motor boat for a trip along the Chao Phraya River and many lively inner canals of Thonburi bank offering fantastic views of the local life nearby. You will have the opportunity to snack, buy trinkets or to use the toilet at stops along the way. Along the way, we stop at Wat Arun, the Temple of Dawn.

Overnight in Bangkok

### **Day 25 (11 Apr 2026): Bangkok : Full day tour - Floating Bangkok - Grand Palace, Wat Po**

The day is yours to experience the beauty of Bangkok at your leisure, where the splendor of the city goes beyond the temples and the palace and onto the river itself.

After breakfast, your private guide and driver will collect you from your hotel for a short drive (30 minutes) heading northwest of Bangkok to Khlong Lat Mayom, one of three floating markets with the charm and authenticity of a local market. (Open on Saturday, Sunday and public holidays only)

Upon arrival, you will take a long-tailed boat tour for 60 minutes along the riverbank of the floating market to see the local products of the area. The floating market displays the vibrancy of Thai life within the everyday routine, from shopping to produce, where the act of buying is as colorful as what is being bought. The market of Khlong Lat Mayom is mostly located along the riverbank, with stalls set up to display the spectacular colors of fresh fruits, from the ripening yellow mangoes to the sweet fragrant coconuts.

Restaurants are set up at low tables along the water giving you a chance to taste local flavors as they're purchased, from the river, from the sea, and from the riverbanks. The delicious and irresistible scent of noodle soup and Pad Thai floats through the market; you could even try something new like the decadent flavor of an oyster omelet. Stop in China Town and enjoy a gastronomic experience as you taste the delicious products of street food heaven.

Discover the bustling Talad Kao Market, offering a variety of fresh food, dried fruits, and Chinese herbs. Finish your fabulous day with a short drive back to Bangkok.

Next, we'll visit the Temple of Reclining Buddha or Wat Pho (Wat Phra Chetuphon) (5 meters long and 1.5 meters wide), the home of the most beautiful and famous Reclining Buddha. The temple housed the 46-meter-long Reclining Buddha image which is the second largest reclining Buddha in the country, (the largest reclining Buddha is 50 meters long at Wat Khun in Pramun, Ang thong province). Wat Pho is the center for the teaching and preservation of traditional Thai medicine and Thai massage.

After lunch (Pay on own), you will visit the Grand Palace. Probably the most visited and remembered landmark of Thailand, the Grand Palace in Bangkok is where every visitor must pay a visit at least once in their lifetime. The Grand Palace served as a significant royal residence until 1925 and is now used for ceremonial purposes only.

Overnight in Bangkok

#### Day 26 (12 Apr 2026): Bangkok - Fly to Vientiane [B]

Check out, meet the driver and transfer to Airport for your flight to Luang Prabang.

Upon your arrival at Luang Prabang airport, you will be greeted and transferred to the hotel for check-in (early check-in subject to availability).

Today's itinerary is free of scheduled activities, allowing you to leisurely explore the charm of this ancient city on your own. Take a stroll to gain your initial impressions of the surroundings. Overnight stay in Luang Prabang.

#### Day 27 (13 Apr 2026): Vientiane city & Buddha park [B]



In the morning, we will first visit **Wat Si Muang**, which is very famous for its supernatural power.

After that drive to **Buddha Park** which takes around 45 minutes away. Also known as Xieng Khuan, this unusual park is filled with over 200 Buddhist and Hindu statues.

Returning to town, visit **COPE**, an association working to help landmine victims. A visit to the center provides in-depth information about the history of the American/Vietnam war and the lasting impact of unexploded ordinances (UXO) in the area and the efforts underway to clear them.

Start the afternoon with a visit to **That Luang**, the holiest site in Laos. Constructed by King Setthathirat in the 16th century, the temple is resplendent as the sun is shines upon its towering golden spire.

Then, enjoy a panoramic view over the city as you climb the stairs to the top of **Patuxay**, Vientiane's own "Arc de Triomphe".

Continue down Lane Xang Avenue the serene **Wat Sisaket**, the only temple left intact after the Siamese (Thai) invasion in 1828.

Continue on to the nearby **Wat Phra Keo**. Used as a religious museum, Wat Phra Keo displays a collection of both Lao and Khmer works of art.

End your tour of the capital along the banks of the **Mekong River** as the sun begins to set.

Stroll along the river, stop to enjoy a cold drink, or sample a snack from one of the many local food stalls.

Overnight in Vientiane.

## Day 28 (14 Apr 2026): Vientiane – Train to Luang Prabang – City Tour [B]

After breakfast at the hotel, we transfer out to the train station to take the speed train to Vientiane (ABOUT 2 HOURS) (NO GUIDE ON BOARD)

Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel in town.

After that, our guide will take you on an in-depth walking tour of the city.

The walk is oriented towards **the lesser-known parts of the town** including charming lanes showing the more traditional atmosphere of the heritage town.

Along the way, we will see the **four different types of buildings categorized by UNESCO**.

The first one is the **traditional Lao house** which is made from tropical hardwood or bamboo and built on stilts.

The second is a **half wood and half cement house** built after the arrival of the French.

The third is the **traditional French colonial building** that are similar to those found in Vietnam and Cambodia.

The last form of architecture you will see is the **old Chinese shop houses** that were built to be used for both commercial and residential purposes.

Overnight in Luang Prabang.

## Day 29 (15 Apr 2026): Luang Prabang – Pak Ou Caves [B]



After breakfast, you will first visit **Royal Palace Museum**, which was built in 1904 during the French colonial era for King Sisavang Vong and his family.

We then embark on a leisure cruise upstream on the Mekong River, which also gives us a breathtaking view of the tranquil countryside, before reaching the mysterious **Pak Ou Caves**, two linked caves crammed with thousands of gold lacquered Buddha statues of various shapes and sizes left by pilgrims.

Along the way, we stop at the village of Ban Xanghai, where they make the local rice wine.

On arrival back in the city, we will visit the old **Wat Sene** and the nearby magnificent **Wat Xiengthong** a superb piece of Lao temple architecture, which presents a sweeping two-tiered roof and ornate mosaics including a beautiful 'tree of life' glass montage on the rear temple wall.

Next, we will visit **Heuan Chan**, a 19th-century aristocratic mansion that offers a glimpse into Lao culture through traditional ceremonies, textiles, and family life. This restored mansion stands as a testament to Lao heritage, featuring enriching exhibitions and a documentary on Laos' customs. After the visit, we'll have the opportunity to taste authentic Lao coffee or tea, providing a true taste of Laos.

Late afternoon, we will make a stop at **Wat Prabath** to admire the sunset; this is the ideal place to catch the last beauty of the day.

The tour ends after a visit to the famous **Night Market**, where you can find a lovely collection of handmade textiles made by local and hilltribe people surrounding Luang Prabang.

Overnight in Luang Prabang

### **Day 30 (16 Apr 2026): Luang Prabang - Kuangsy Waterfall [B]**

After breakfast at the hotel, we ascend the 329 steps to the top of **Phousi Hill** for a panoramic view of the city and the Mekong River.

We then visit the **Buffalo Dairy Farm**, which is the first of its kind in Laos. The farm helps Lao farmer have benefits from the dairy products from their buffaloes, that they cannot imagine before. This then takes us to the beautiful **Kuang Si waterfalls** which is the biggest in the Luang Prabang area with three tiers leading to a 50-metre drop into spectacular azure pools before flowing downstream. The pools also make great swimming holes and are very popular with both tourists and locals.

You have the rest of the afternoon to refresh with the cool clear water, or hiking to the top of the waterfalls. There is also the chance to walk to the nearby village of **Ban Thapene**, and explore the hidden waterfalls, which is rarely visited by other tourists. If you wish, we will also take a short visit to the **Bear Rescue Center**, which houses a couple of dozen animals rescued from the hands of poachers and traffickers. On the way back to Luang Prabang, we will take a short visit to the **Ock Pop Tock Living Craft Center**, set serenely close to the Mekong, this beautiful, traditionally styled workshop, where weavers, spinners and batik makers produce top-quality fabrics, offers free tours every half-hour. This is also one of the best spots to admire the sunset in Luang Prabang



Transfer back to your hotel late afternoon.  
Overnight in Luang Prabang.

#### **Day 31 (17 Apr 2026): Luang Prabang - Departure [B]**

You are free to stroll around the town for your own exploration before taking the departure flight
